

The Headless Way

On October 26 our fellowship hosted a very special event for the community; a day-long workshop titled **The Headless Way**. The program was presented by Richard Lang at the South Coast Hospice Community Education Center. Twenty-seven people attended; many but not all are SCUUF members.

Sequoia Star led the effort to bring Mr. Lang to Coos Bay – including arranging an alternate flight for him from San Francisco to Eugene after his original arrangements into North Bend were cancelled. That meant he also got the scenic tour of the backside of Coos Bay thanks to the McCullough closure. His next stop was Philadelphia.
